CONTRACT FOR LEVEL ONE (no monitor)

I acknowledge that my child has been ordered into the Intensive Probation Program as a condition of probation and suspension of commitment to the Indiana Department of Corrections.

1. I, _____, will remain in my home (address: _____) phone (_____) for the duration of this program unless given specific permission to leave by an Intensive Probation Officer. The only exception is a life-threatening emergency and I understand, if possible, I must first attempt to notify my Probation Officer immediately. If my Probation Officer is not available, I will notify the Lake County Juvenile Center at 769-4664. This notification process does not constitute permission to leave my home but does provide preliminary documentation of an emergency. Following the emergency, I understand I must provide written documentation to the Intensive Probation Officer to substantiate the deviation from the schedule.
2. Telephone calls will be made to my residence at random times of the day or night. The time and number of calls may vary and may be made at any time.
3. Unscheduled home visits may be made at any time of the day or night to ensure my compliance with the Intensive Probation Program. Representatives of the Probation Department will be allowed inside for the purpose of checking the child's room.
4. School visits will be made at any time during school hours to ensure my compliance with the Intensive Probation Program.
5. Employment visits may be made at any time of the day or night to ensure my compliance with the Intensive Probation Program.
6. Other conditions may be ordered as part of the treatment program which may include, but not limited to the following:
 - a) Individual counseling (juvenile and/or parent/guardian)
 - b) Family Counseling (therapy)
 - c) Group therapy
 - d) Education/Vocational training

- e) Community service
- f) Restitution
- g) Urinalysis random test (failure to take will result in a modification)
- h) BAC (breathalyzer) random test (failure to take will result in a modification)

7. There will be periodic reassessments done on your case.

8. I understand that any violation of the program could result in my apprehension and transportation to the Lake County Juvenile Center by a Probation Officer and/or Surveillance Officer.

This is a sample of violations that my get you further sanctions or picked up and detained at LCJC but not an all inclusive list:

- a) *New criminal charges*
- b) *Failed drug test*
- c) *Failed BAC test*
- d) *Suspension from school*
- e) *In-school suspension or detention*
- f) *Leaving the house without permission*
- g) *Having more than two friends over*
- h) *Having inappropriate friends over*
- i) *Failure to follow "callout" procedure*

9. The Intensive Probation Program has a Callout Policy for children placed on Level One status. The policy is as follows:

- a. Level One children may be approved for one "callout" of no more than four hours for the weekend which starts on Friday at 4:00 p.m. and ends on Sunday at 6:00 p.m.
- b. There will be no "callouts" on the nights preceding a school day (Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday). No "callouts" on Sunday evenings after 6:00 p.m. The only exception to this rule will be school events, work, church functions and counseling.
- c. All "callouts" for Friday evenings, Saturday and Sunday must be phoned to, and approved, by an Intensive Probation Officer or Surveillance Officer no later than 3:00 p.m. on the preceding Thursday.
- d. Do not call the Intensive Probation Department, or the Lake County Juvenile Center during the weekend to request "callouts". It will not be granted.
- e. Parent or guardian will be the only person to call the child out.
- f. Parent or guardian must accompany the child on an approved "callout".

10. You will be allowed to have only two friends at your home at any time and they must be approved by the Intensive Staff and your parent/guardian.

11. If the juvenile receives an out-of-school suspension, the juvenile must contact the Intensive Probation office that same day. During the time the juvenile is suspended, alternative sanctions may be ordered.
12. If the juvenile is ill, absent for school, receives an in-school suspension or detention, it is the responsibility of the juvenile to contact the Intensive Probation office immediately. (All illnesses and absences must be called in to the Intensive Probation office not later than 8:45 a.m. that same school day).
13. This Program will continue from the time it is ordered by the Court until I am specifically released.
14. I understand that any violation of the Program could result in my apprehension and transportation to the Lake County Juvenile Center.
